

# Someone Did Something!

Who? What? Where? When? Why?  
Subject and Object Questions – Simple Past

**Task:** Imagine you heard some gossip about **someone who did something** but you don't know any details. Talk to your friend to find out as much as possible by asking questions. For situations 1 to 4 your partner has some notes to answer your questions. For situations 5 – 10 your partner has to come up with his/her own ideas. Take turns after each situation. Example:

Situation: **Someone played something.**

A: *Who played something?*

B: *Amelia and George played something.*

A: *What did Amelia and George play?*

B: *They played board games.*

A: *Where did they play board games?*

B: *They played board games in their garden.*
