

# Compound Word Pictionary

## Online-Rules

- What you need: a drawing app and lists of compound-words. Choose compound words that allow for each element do be drawn, e.g. doghouse, sunglasses, etc.
- The aim of the game is to guess the compound word based on a drawing. The rules are a little more like Charades than the actual Pictionary.
- Divide your class in sub-groups of three students.
- Ask two or three sub-groups to play in one breakout-room.
- In their breakout-rooms, ask the students to open Paint or a Whiteboard or any other app that allows drawing.
- Make sure none of the students open any word lists before they start the game.
- Sub-group 1 goes first and nominates an 'artist' to draw the words on word list 1a. Make sure the other members of sub-group 1 do not open or see this list!
- Set a timer for the artist to draw as many words on the list as possible within 5 minutes while his or her sub-group members are trying to guess the words. Count the words that were guessed correctly.
- Do three rounds with the following turn-taking order: 1a, 2a, 3a, 1b, 2b, 3b, etc.
- The team that has guessed most words is the winner.
